

(1) Develop the ability to work as part of a team in the field (with the client) as a technical liaison to report progress and receive clarification, suggestions, and direction; occasional meetings with one or more experts in fields pertinent to the problem (perhaps on-campus seminars or workshops conducted by experts); occasional trips, perhaps to the client's location.

is accomplished by each student 1  
 keeping a personal journal, contributing to the class written report, and submitting a value-added paper (which expresses what s/he has learned and how s/he has grown in the course). The class presents to the client an oral report, and its planning becomes a pre-writing exercise for the written report. 14
